Skills First Reconnect

Through Skills First Reconnect, selected Registered Training Organisations will provide disengaged high needs learners with access to wrap around services that will enable them to re-engage and succeed in further education and employment. Learners referred to Skills First Reconnect must be aged between 17 and 64 years of age. Skills First Reconnect RTOs will support:

- high needs learners aged 17 to 19 who have not completed Year 12 or equivalent and are not in education, training or full-time employment
- individuals aged 20 to 64 who have not completed Year 12 or equivalent and who are long term unemployed.




