Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning

A vocationally focussed senior secondary certificate delivered across three streams with certificates available at each level or as a buildable program

VET Vocational Education and Training

Allows students to include vocational studies within their senior secondary certificate. Students undertake nationally recognised training that contributes to their VCE or VCAL.

VCE Vocational Major

A vocational and applied learning program within the VCE designed to be completed over a minimum of two years

VPC

Victorian Pathways Certificate an inclusive Year 11 and 12 standards-based certificate that meets the needs of a smaller number of students who are not able or ready to complete the VCE

VPC is not a senior secondary qualification, it can be a pathway to the VCE.

VET

Vocational Education and Training
